## Description

Lately, I've been thinking about time travel. Not the most original of thoughts, but still something to mull over during the wee hours of the morning.

I cannot remember which show, [if you know which one, PLEASE let me know :)] but one had a very interesting theory which I shall share with you all now (with a little David-ness thrown in, of course).

Let's say you have an event on a linear time scale (because time is linear):

Past Event Future

The past is before the event, and the future is after this event.
